



# COVID-19 - Club Small Grant Scheme - Westmeath Sports Partnership

## **Grant Criteria, Terms and Conditions**

### Who can Apply:

- Clubs/Groups/Organisations who are based in County Westmeath
- Affiliated sports and physical activity clubs, community groups and disability organisations
- Clubs and Organisations who operate as a not for profit group and be open for public membership

### Who is ineligible to apply:

- Individuals
- Clubs/Groups/Organisations who have received Coivid 19 support grants previously from Local Authority and/or National Governing Body's. *Double funding checks will be conducted at local and national level.*
- National/Regional/County Governing Bodies/ Statutory agencies
- For profit groups/commercial organisations / Private Facility owners
- Applications eligible for funding under other similar schemes will not be considered in this scheme e.g. community development grants. This fund is specific to sport related applications

#### What can you apply for:

- This grant would cover costs associated with reopening of clubs.
- Costs associated with the implementation of necessary safety measures under Sport Ireland: Return to Sport Guidelines.
- The level of grant assistance will not exceed €1,500 per application.

#### **Terms and Conditions**

- Clubs/Groups with juvenile members must operate under the basis of best practice for children in sport a member of the club must have previously attended a Child Welfare & Protection Awareness course (new clubs must commit to attending training where appropriate)
- Groups must be affiliated to Westmeath Public Participation Network (WPPN).
- Salary costs are not eligible for funding.
- An expenditure report, including all receipts, will be required as evidence of grant usage. Failure to supply these will result in grant repayment and/or exclusion from further funding opportunities.
- A Tax Number or Charity Number is required for all grants.
- If successful, it is a requirement of all grant funding that Westmeath Sports Partnership is acknowledged as a source of funding in any publications, leaflets, signage, online etc.
- Applications will not be accepted after the closing date.
- Due consideration will be given to ensuring an equitable allocation of funds throughout the county

Closing date for applications is 5.30pm on Monday 31st of August 2020
